SUBJECT: All-Division Selections

The following is Section C of Article 11 of the Central Conference By-Laws:

Section C: Conference All Division Selection

1. Coaches of division will select twelve Conference All Division players.
2. Procedure:
 - a. Each coach will nominate players from his/her own team (6 only), deserving of All Division consideration, and mail this list to the Conference Secretary on the Monday following the last regular season game (week 18 of the NSAA calendar).
 - b. The Conference Secretary will print ballots for each division. The ballot is to include all players nominated by the coaches. A division ballot is to be mailed to each coach during the 19th week of the NSAA calendar.
 - c. Each coach is to rank the best twelve players, in his/her estimation. The best player is to receive 12 points regressing to 1 point for the twelfth best player.
 - d. A coach CAN vote for players from his/her own team.
 - e. The coaches are to meet at 7:00pm on the Wednesday of the 19th week of the NSAA calendar. East Division coaches will meet at Seward High School and West Division coaches will meet at Central City High School.
 - f. The six players receiving the most points in the balloting will be accorded All Division 1st team honors and the next six players in the voting will be accorded All Division 2nd team honors.
 - g. If a tie should occur for twelfth position, it will be broken and the player receiving the highest ranking will be included on the All Division team. In the tie-breaking balloting a coach may vote for his/her own player.
 - h. A player not selected for 1st or 2nd team, but receiving two votes (appears on 2 ballots) will be named Honorable Mention.

The following are important dates to make the All Division selection work.
